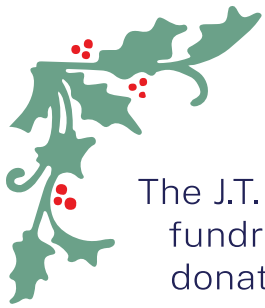
receives meals is wonderful to deal with; always friendly and thankful.
